LEMHI COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD MINUTES

July 11, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Fred McDonald at 18:05. Board members in attendance: Fred McDonald, chairman, Richard Natelson, Bob Deurloo, Cecil Jackson, and Bill Loudy. Also present: Lenny Skunberg from Lenny's Airmotive.

The old minutes from June's meeting were reviewed. Cecil made a motion to approve the old minutes. This was seconded by Rich. The motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

A bill was received from Western Petroleum for \$7903 dollars. This was for a Prist injector that was purchased from this company back in April 2008. The agreement was signed by Tom Conrad. Thirteen cents per gallon surcharge was placed to pay for this injector. Apparently, the contract was forgotten by the Board and the company also forgot about it. The Board does not know whether any payments were made to Western Petroleum. It was decided to check with Vicky (former bookkeeper) to see if any payments were made.

Fuel Hose: Dave Shallow will be helping Lenny install the new fuel hose at the fuel island.

NEW BUSINESS:

Fuel Report: There are 6627 gallons of Avgas at Pump # 1. There are 5455 gallons of Avgas at Pump # 2, and 7706 gallons of Jet A.

The Airport has been passing tests with regard to the tank monitoring system.

The fuel dispenser at Pump #1 is inoperative. Lepco of Idaho Falls will come to repair the system for \$350 plus repair costs.

Courtesy Car: One hundred and ten dollars in donations were received from the pilots using the car. The speedometer is inoperative. Bob will see how much it will cost to repair it.

Bathroom Usage: It came to the attention of the Board that reportedly, McCall Air refused to allow bus passengers to use the bathroom at their facility.

According to the Airport Handbook, if an FBO is located at the Airport, bathroom facilities must be provided. The Board will investigate the matter to determine what actually transpired.

A motion was made by Bob to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Cecil. The meeting was subsequently adjourned.
