AIRPORT BOARD MINUTES
September 13, 2010

Call to order was performed by Fred McDonald, Present were Loren Bills, Bill Loudy, Fred McDonald and Richard Natelson.

A motion was made to accept the minutes from Augusts' meeting, by Loren. It was seconded by Richard. The motion carried unanimously.

Due to work being performed at the airport, Fred stated that he would be putting out NOTAMS for airport closures. This would be for Monday through Wednesday for 13:00 to 17:00 hours. The work would reportedly be completed by the end of the week.

FUEL REPORT: As of today, there were 3291 gallons of Jet A, 6669 gallons of AVGAS in Pump 2 and 5444 gallons in Pump 1. Lenny Skunberg stated that the entire fuel farm was to be inspected by Brett Schmidt. He would be inspecting for Exxon Mobil.

Lenny also stated that the new equipment for the fuel farm is on order and ready to be shipped.

It was also stated that the credit card reader for the pumps needs to be modified or replaced. This is so that no credit card numbers are displayed on the receipts.

The Board was reportedly approached by concerned citizens wanting the Salmon Board to provide maintenance for the Leadore airport. The Board was not certain if it was responsible for the airport.

The Board will want to determine under whose jurisdiction the Leadore airport falls.

The Board decided to send Bill Loudy to Leadore in order to determine what would be needed.

A motion was made by Fred to end the meeting. It was seconded by Bill. The meeting was adjourned.
