

LEMHI COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD MINUTES

August 4, 2014

In the absence of both the Chairman and the Vice Chairman, the meeting was called to order by the former chairman, Fred McDonald at 18:10. Board members in attendance: Richard Natelson, Bob Deurloo, Bill Loudy, and Fred McDonald. Also in attendance was Lenny Skunberg, as well as Dan Schroeder and Joann Wolters from Gem Air.

FUEL REPORT

As of today there are 4682 gallons of av gas in Pump # 1, 3235 gallons of av gas in Pump # 2, and 2265 gallons of Jet A.

Lenny stated that there is a load of jet fuel coming tomorrow.

Lenny has been monitoring the jet fuel usage carefully. Reportedly, there is a problem with the "pulser" that sends a signal from the pump to the computer. Lepco, the company that would fix the problem, has been called more than once. We are still waiting to hear from them.

Financial Report

Ms Wolters stated that she feels that the fuel billing has been in error. She stated that if the cost of the fuel was .07 cents, it was being charged at .7 cents.

The Board stated that if this is indeed the case, a correction is in order.

OLD BUSINESS:

New Business:

Tie downs

Ms Wolters stated that their company did not receive four free tie downs with their lease agreement. Fred countered that indeed they did. They had a total of 8 tie-downs: four they paid for and four that came with the lease.

It will be discussed further at next meeting. Mr. Schroeder mentioned also that he would like to talk to Tony about the leases.

Snow Removal

Mr. Schroeder stated that he would like to help with snow plowing and that perhaps more training on how to plow around tie downs is in order. He stated that often the tie down chains are left and the plow breaks the chains. This leaves pieces of chain on the asphalt that could damage plane tires.

It was suggested by the Board that perhaps rope should be used, or perhaps all tie down chains should be removed in the winter thereby eliminating the problem.

The meeting was adjourned at 18:45.
